




About the Founder



"It was an evening for mingling, networking, jamming and showcasing as the Speak Life Tour held its finale in Baltimore. If you were a young person in the area, the Eubie Blake Cultural Center (www.eubieblake.org), 847 N. Howard Street, became the hippest place to be Saturday, September 20, 2014, beginning at 6pm. The Speak Life Tour (SLT) featured spoken word, song, poetry and hip hop presentations, all with positive messages, along with education and self-acceptance. The tour was the brainchild of New Beginnings Executive Director Catherine Trotter, who began the plenary phase in January. Her SLT team consisted of DJ Rube Rice, Tameka Harris and Mark Davis.
